The **Baccalaureate Mass** will be held **Friday, May 27, 2016 at 6:00 pm at Roncalli High School**. Tickets are not needed for this celebration. Seniors arrive by 5:30 p.m. and meet in the cafeteria.

The **Commencement ceremony will be held on Saturday, May 28, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. at Roncalli High School**. Tickets are only needed if there is inclement weather forcing the ceremony inside.

Seniors should meet in the cafeteria no later than 8:30 a.m. Immediately following the graduation ceremony, please report to the cafeteria to receive your diploma and return your graduation gown. Students may keep the cap and tassel.

No diploma will be issued to any senior class member who has an academic deficiency or delinquent obligations placed against him/her.



COMMENCEMENT TICKET POLICY

Graduation will be held in the stadium for the Class of 2016 in order to accommodate the many requests for seating. Tickets are not required for stadium seating; however, **if rain is in the forecast or threatened, the graduation will be held in the “Family Room” and seating will be by ticket only.**

Seniors will be given the following tickets:

- 4 seats (open seating) in the Family Room
- 2 auditorium seats for the video simulcast



May 5, 2016: Distribution of tickets will be during all lunch periods. A copy of the immunization record will also be provided to each student.

Handicapped Parking and Seating for Graduation Activities:

Handicapped parking for graduation and wheelchair seating for graduation and baccalaureate are available upon request. The first several rows of bleachers in the stadium will be reserved for general handicapped seating for graduation. This seating is available on a first-come basis. **Reserved parking will only be held until 8:30 am.** For wheelchair seating and handicapped parking, please submit your request in writing to Mrs. Sheets (msheets@roncalli.org) before May 20, 2016.

Proper Attire...Take Pride in Your Appearance



SENIOR MASS: Business Attire

Men: Dress shirt with a tie. Dark dress slacks/pants. Dark socks and dark dress shoes. No shorts or sweats of any type and no denim or jeans. No hats. No tennis shoes. No sunglasses. No flip-flops.

Women: Dress OR skirt and blouse OR dress slacks and blouse with dress shoes. No prom dresses or off the shoulder dresses. **BUSINESS ATTIRE!** Women should be appropriately attired in regards to the length of the skirt/dress. There should be no cleavage visible. Capri pants are not business attire. No tennis shoes. No sunglasses. No denim or jeans. No flip-flops.

Failure to comply will result in the student not participating in the liturgy.

BACCALAUREATE AND COMMENCEMENT: FORMAL ACADEMIC ATTIRE

Men: Blue cap and blue gown with red, white, and blue tassel. A solid color dress shirt, tie, and dark, solid colored dress slacks should be worn. No denim or jeans. Dark dress shoes and dark socks are appropriate footwear. No tennis shoes. No sunglasses. No cigars. No flip-flops.

Women: Red cap and red gown with red, white, and blue tassel. Under the gown women should wear a dress or skirt and blouse with solid color dress shoes. Solid color dress slacks are also acceptable. No denim or jeans. Wear comfortable shoes in which you can easily maneuver on the stairs, the track, and the stadium turf. No tennis shoes. No sunglasses. No cigars. No flip-flops.

Failure to comply will result in the student not participating in the event.

ALL GRADUATES:

Caps are worn flat on the top of the head with the point of the cap in the middle of the forehead. Tassels are worn on the right side of the cap until such time as commencement honors are bestowed upon the graduates. No writing on the top of the cap. **Students with writing on his/her cap will forfeit their cap.**

Students deemed inappropriately dressed will be asked to change into appropriate attire. They will not participate in the activity until appropriately attired.
