In addition to his gift for helping others in need, Dr. Tom had a real passion for Roncalli High School and its Performing Arts, as all three of his children, Erin R'02, Lauren R'05 and Austin R'10 graduated from Roncalli and participated in countless plays, musicals, Show Choir competitions and productions.
