Jennifer did her student teaching during college at Winchester Village Elementary School, on the Southside of Indianapolis. She graduated from Purdue with a degree in Elementary Education. After college, she coached softball and was teaching at North Park Academy in Indianapolis, when she became ill and left this earth on July 19, 2008. This memorial scholarship was established in the winter of 2012 by her parents, Luke and Diana McKinney.
