OVERVIEW:

Roncalli High School is a four-year interparochial high school operated by the Roncalli High School Board of Directors under the auspices of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Indianapolis. Roncalli High School is accredited by the Indiana State Department of Education and the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. Our school is located in a residential, suburban community of Marion County (in Indianapolis) and is approximately ten miles from the center of downtown Indianapolis.

Our school has been recognized four times as a **Blue Ribbon School of Excellence** by the United States of Department of Education, most recently in 2024. The service program earned the **"Set A Good Example Award"** from the Concerned Businessmen's Association while the Department of Education bestowed a **Special Emphasis Award** for the Service Learning program. The Indiana Department of Education has named Roncalli a **Four Star School** each year for the last 12 years.

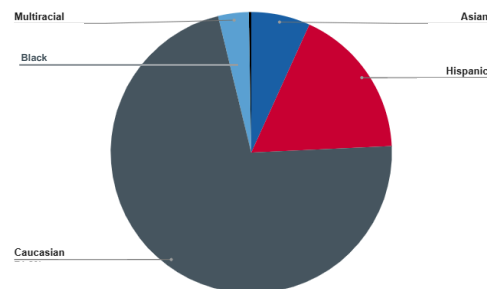

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CURRICULUM:

Roncalli students typically attend seven classes but have the option to enroll in eight. The average class size is 23.7 students. Roncalli offers 20 Advanced Placement courses and 34 Dual Credit courses. Every student enrolled in an Advanced Placement course must take the corresponding Advanced Placement exam.

In 2024-2025, 256 students took an AP class, and of the 465 exams given, 82% earned a score of 3, 4 or 5. Roncalli does not rank students, but was proud to recognize 70 students who were named AP Scholars, AP Scholars with Honors, and AP Scholars with Distinction. The Class of 2025 had five students who were recognized as National Merit Commended Scholars and one student who was a National Merit Semifinalist.
