

Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) - 2027-2028

The *Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act* (FERPA), a Federal law, requires that Roncalli High School, with certain exceptions, obtain your written consent prior to the disclosure of personally identifiable information from your child's education records. However, Roncalli High School may disclose appropriately designated "directory information" without written consent, unless you have advised the Roncalli High School to the contrary in accordance with Roncalli High School procedures. The primary purpose of directory information is to allow the Roncalli High School to include information from your child's education records in certain school publications. Examples include (but are not limited to):

- A playbill, showing your student's role in a drama production;
- The annual yearbook;
- Honor roll or other recognition lists;
- Graduation programs; and
- Sports activity sheets, such as for wrestling, showing weight and height of team members.

If you do not want Roncalli High School to disclose any or all of the types of information designated below as directory information from your child's education records without your prior written consent, you must notify the Roncalli High School in writing by August 1st, 2027. This notice can be sent to registrar@roncalli.org. Roncalli has designated the following information as directory information:

- Student's name
- Address
- Telephone listing
- Electronic mail address
- Photograph
- Date and place of birth
- Major field of study
- Dates of attendance
- Grade level
- Participation in officially recognized activities and sports
- Weight and height of members of athletic teams
- Degrees, honors, and awards received
- The most recent educational agency or institution attended
- School produced photographs, videos, and/or audio recordings for educational and other public media deemed appropriate by Roncalli High School.
